Bottle

## Sauvignon Blanc Russiz Superiore Feluga, Italy

£54.95

*Intriguing aromas of pink grapefruit, green peppers and fresh sage. Crisp citrus flavours, particularly lemon and grapefruit, dominate and linger on the well-structured palate. This is brilliantly distinctive Sauvignon.*

## Carneros Chardonnay, Napa Valley, USA

£64.95

*A restrained style of California Chardonnay, with pear and citrus fruit backed up with the slightest hint of barrel-derived spice. Quite firm and structured on the palate, made in an elegant, food-friendly style.*

## Chablis Grand Cru Les Clos, Jean Marc Brocard, France

£69.95

*Complex yet very refined, showing some mineral, smoke, flint, lemon and a touch of honeyed complexity. Full-bodied and layered with exquisite flavours and a long finish.*

## Meursault Vieilles Vignes, Vincent Girardin, France

£74.95

*Made from 60yo vines, this wine always expresses the minerality that we expect from Puligny. Very fine and restrained on the nose. Concentrated tight minerality with grapefruit notes. Very fine slatey fruit palate.*

## Chassagne-Montrachet 1er Cru Les Vide-Bourse, Thomas Morey, France

£89.95

*Rounder, meaty and have a slightly mineral but long finish in the mouth. This wine has its place among the best of the 1er crus.*

## Corton-Charlemagne Grand Cru, Vincent Girardin, France

£99.95

*This is very forward, rich and creamy yet with plenty of muscle and minerality. Superb in every dimension, with terrific length, there is almost a palatable energy here.*



# Red Wines

**Privada, Malbec/Cabernet/Merlot, Bodega Norton, Argentina**

£54.95

*Excellent aromatic complexity with notes of ripe fruit, spices, and hints of smoke and coffee. Rich and generous on the palate with superb concentration.*

**Barolo, Piedmont, Prunotto, Italy**

£64.95

*Imposing single-site Barolo. On the nose, an intense perfume of plum and ripe cherry with hints of flowers and spicy aromas. On the palate, concentrated and profound, with soft texture and a long finish.*

**Chateauneuf-du-Pape Haute-Pierre, Domaine Delas, France**

£74.95

*This offers a heady blend of power, fruit and spice. Cherry, raspberry and baked plum mingle with fresh pepper and the herbs of the garrigue. Deft despite its weight, the palate finishes dry and refreshing.*

**Vaio Amaron Amarone Classico, Serego Alighieri, Italy**

£84.95

*Concentrated and elegant nose with hints of spices and sumptuous ripe red fruit. The velvety palate is dominated by the same notes, with added flavour of wild flowers and herbs. Dry on the finish with an excellent length.*

**Antica Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley, Famiglia Antinori, USA**

£89.95

*Rich and concentrated with notes of blackcurrant, plum and black cherry. Toasty oak picks up hints of mocha and espresso. Well-balanced with a touch of mineral and rich concentrated fruit flavours.*

**Tignanello, Tuscany IGT, Famiglia Antinori, Italy**

£99.95

*A concentrated Tignanello with ripe red fruit and spice aromas, as well as vanilla and toasty notes from the oak. The palate, while still youthful, is powerful and complex, expressing a great sense of place as well as the ideal weather conditions leading up to the harvest.*
